Experience the exciting sounds of Nebraska's largest Theatre Pipe Organ. See the rooms containing pipes and musical instrument varieties. The music program will take a trip back to the time when the pipe organ was the dominant instrument in theatres and will include a silent movie and sing-along. Following the concert enjoy a box lunch before moving on to the Strategic Air and Space Museum. More than 30 famous military aircraft and missiles are on display as a celebration of aviation and those who served at the Strategic Air Command. You will be able to watch the restoration of warplanes as technicians prepare them for display.

Enjoy a 1-1/2 hour cruise with a Historical Society Guide providing a narrative on the expedition and early Omaha, elaborating on sites seen along the shore as well as side stories on such history as Lewis and Clark Landing where Clark came ashore in 1804 and examined mounds of earth that he thought to be remains of an early Otoe Village and other discoveries along this Nebraska corridor of the Missouri River. Following the cruise visit the famous Old Market in downtown Omaha filled with unique shops, restaurants and historic buildings. Walk the cobblestone streets, enjoy lunch (on your own) and explore the more than 100 businesses located in the red brick warehouses.
